

FABRIC COLORING WITH TSUKINEKO INK

Taught by Joyce Teng

Students to Provide

- Masking tape or painter tape
- Paper towel
- Barbasol foam shaving cream
- Two 2 Oz CLEAR spray bottles with one-third of 70% or 90% rubbing alcohol
- Brown lunch paper bag
- Cotton Fabrics - 6 pieces of 6" square white and 6 pieces of 6" square white printed; 6 pieces of 6" square black/white printed
- Two pieces of 3"x22" white printed;
- Two pieces 13"x 13" white.
- CLOTHES HANGER WITH CLIPS (HOLDS FABRIC IN THE AIR WHILE SPRAYING)
- Optional - Apron, sleeve protector; Scissors; your own Tsukineko All Purpose Fabric Inks, and coloring tools, like sponge daubers, fantastic foam tips, or art sponges.
