



Carve, Stamp, Color: stamp making with Lisa Thorpe



Create your own pattern stamps to use again and again on fabric and paper. I will teach you how to carve both simple and elaborate repeat pattern blocks to use as focal points or borders in your fabric art and quilting. You will also learn how to colorize your designs using Derwent Inktense colored pencils making the design possibilities endless with the unique and personal stamp blocks. The morning will be devoted to designing and carving up to 6 repeat pattern blocks in 3 sizes. In the afternoon we will be printing and learning to color on fabric with the Dewent InkTense pencils to cap off the day.

\$30 Kit fee: Your kit includes 3 soft cut print blocks in 3 sizes that can be carved on both sides to create 6 stamps, carving tool, Versa Craft fabric ink pad in black, a Fat quarter of washed PFD fabric ready to print and colorize, GAC 900 fabric medium, cups for medium, paint brushes in a variety of sizes to use.

Supplies students need to bring:

- Dewent Inktense pencil set of 12 or larger ([click here to see options](#))
(NOTE: If don't want to buy Derwent Inktense Pencils or sign up too late and don't have time to buy I will have several sets of Inktense pencils for a sharing table)
- Sketchbook or notebook with plain white paper for designing and stamping blocks
- Pencil (soft pencil like HB or 2B not a mechanical pencil)
- Pack of wet wipes or baby wipes for cleaning stamp and fingers
- craft or paper scissors
