

Sunlit Sunflowers Fabric Collage

Sunlit sunflowers is good introduction to collage. In class you will get a choice of either the red or yellow sunflower kit with the pattern and included are a variety of bright colored fabrics. Colors and fabrics will vary from the samples shown but I do try to keep them similar. Approximate size 12"- 15"



The Kit includes: a variety of fabrics from scraps to small pieces, the foundation interfacing and pattern.

You will need:

Fabric Collage Tools:

- Pencil,
- Chalk marking tool, or disappearing pen. I like the Bohin chalk marker.
- Fabric glue with fine nozzle or glue applicator I use Alennes Original Tacky Glue
- Good, sharp small scissors (I use Karen Kay Buckley 6" scissors)
- Small trash bag is useful
- Optional: Lightbox. Battery powered to work in the classroom
- Optional: Tweezers

Not needed for class but to finish the project.

Background fabric I choose once the collage is made.
Batting, backing fabric and binding

You may bring other fabrics to use also if you wish to work in your own color scheme or add to the fabrics in the kit. (Scraps are good)
