Fish and Stitch Fabric Collage.

Fish and Stitch is a small colorful project, an introduction to fabric collage. The kit include a variety of colored fabrics to choose from. Colors and fabrics will vary from the samples shown but I do try to keep them similar. The fish is about 10" and can be made as a fish shape or it can be used as part of a larger quilt. It is perfect for adding simple hand stitching. As time allows students will begin hand stitching or make another fish. The project can be finished at home.

The

Kit includes: a variety of fabrics from scraps

to small pieces, pattern, batting, embroidery thread and needle.

You will need:

Fabric Collage Tools:

- Pencil,
- Chalk marking tool, or disappearing pen. I like the Bohin chalk marker.
- Glue Stick or a light fabric glue
- Good, sharp small scissors (I use Karen Kay Buckley 6" scissors)
- Small trash bag is useful
- Optional: Lightbox. Battery powered to work in the classroom
- Optional: Tweezers

Not needed for class but to finish the project.

Backing fabric, border, and binding

You may bring other fabrics to use also if you wish to work in your own color scheme or add to the fabrics in the kit. (Scraps are good)
