## FLOATING IRIS ART QUILT



In this class you will create a floating art quilt with three colorful Iris flowers actually moving away from the front of the art quilt.

Designing unique dimensional flowers will take your 2-dimensional creativity to a 3-dimensional piece of art.

This is a fun way to expand your creativity and leave the class knowing how to add dimensional artwork to your quilts, purses, bags, pillows, etc.

You will have enough time to complete this art quilt. I encourage you to also change any design elements as you develop your 3-D floral art quilt.

You will leave this class inspired to learn more and create more 3-dimensional art quilts.

**The Kit:** Everything is included in the kit to create this beautiful Iris floating art quilt. The kit contains all fused fabrics for the flowers. The backing and batting are fused to the quilt front fabric ready for you to start designing the floral arrangement. All the embellishments are included.

All the directions and supportive pictures are also included in the kit. I will demonstrate several techniques for creating different 3-D floating art quilts.

### YOU WILL NEED TO BRING:

The following crayons: White, light and dark purple, yellow, orange, brown, pink and red. You will use crayons to highlight the flowers. If you own Inktense pens in the required colors, you can bring them instead of crayons.

Pen or pencil and notepad for notes.

Scissors: cloth and paper scissors to cut patterns and fabrics.

Quilt Festival Education Department provides irons and ironing surfaces in all classrooms.

Feel free to video my demonstrations and take pictures during the class. Relax, enjoy the creative processes and meet new friends.
