Dear Prospective Exhibitor:

Thank you for your interest in joining International Quilt Festival as an exhibitor. We are always interested in new exhibitors and their products. Festival in 2025 will take place in Houston Oct. 9 – Oct. 12 with Preview Night Oct. 8.

To maintain the high standards set for Quilt Festival, we require the following from prospective exhibitors:

- □ A letter from you indicating that you are interested in exhibiting in the Quilt Festival, and that your company has been producing or selling its product lines for one year or more along with the company website.
- □ A recommendation letter from a business associate in the industry.
- Product samples or photo/s of the items to be sold at Festival, such as a catalog, a sample pattern, or other substantiation of the line of products to be cleared by the Festival Screening Committee. Keep in mind that we are a textile-related show, and we require that at least 90% of the merchandise you bring to Festival be related to this theme.

The requirements for all editions of the International Quilt Festival are the same. Please submit your request letter and other requirements to the above e-mail. If you are interested in exhibiting at the fall Quilt Market wholesale trade show, you must undergo the same screening process.

We will notify you of the action taken by the Screening Committee through e-mail. If your company has been accepted as a new exhibitor, you will also receive a contract of the Festival following your acceptance. The contract packet contains information on booth types, prices, and add-ons. It is our company policy to release booth pricing information only after you have passed the screening process.

We look forward to hearing from you and we hope that you will be able to join us at Festival as an exhibitor. We have also enclosed an information sheet on the Quilt Festival for your use in advance planning.

HISTORY OF THE FESTIVAL

The International Quilt Festival began in 1975. It is the largest annual consumer quilt show in the world with attendees from all over the U.S. and more than 25 countries around the world. The fall edition of International Quilt Festival is held in Houston, immediately after the International Quilt Market. We also have editions in other cities. International Quilt Festival is produced by Quilts, Inc., which also produces International Quilt Market, the world's only wholesale trade show dedicated to the quilting and sewing industries. In addition to vendors, we feature hundreds of quilts on display and a wide array of classes with the top teachers in the world.

BOOTH INFORMATION

Booth size is 10' x 10'. Included in the booth rental fee are the following: one 6' or 8' table, two chairs, simple lettered booth identification sign, a listing in the *Quintessential Quilt* show program, and on the shows' website. It is our company policy to release booth pricing information only after the screening process and your company has been accepted. *Note that a half-booth is available and have a footage of 10' x 6'. That means the* **10' is aisle frontage** and the depth of the booth is 6'.

EXHIBITORS AND MERCHANDISE

Quilt Festival is not an antique show, home goods, or craft show. We have developed our reputation because we carefully screen our exhibitors to make sure that their merchandise is suitable for Quilt Festival. Among the types of merchandise that is acceptable are: antique quilts, new quilts, antique tops, new tops, quilt blocks, quilting supplies, computer software, sewing machines, patterns, kits, books, quilt and needlework gift items, baskets, rugs, antique linens and laces, reproduction linens and laces, folk art items, crafts, quilt prints and/or paper goods, sewing supplies (both old and new), quilt racks and frames, wearable art, pillows, and antique beds. Festival also includes **Open Studios™**, an area where attendees can observe live educational demonstrations with artists showing everything from free-motion embroidery and piecing to mono-printing and embellishment.

There were more than 42,000 quilt lovers from all parts of the world in attendance at the 2024 International Quilt Festival in Houston, Texas.

PROSPECTIVE EXHIBITORS
